Dorm check-in

For successful check-in, please, prepare these documents in advance:

- 2 colored document photos (3*4)
- Medical certificates with translation (Chronic diseases; photofluorography, HIV-negative certificate, Vaccination Records)

Then read the dorm's safety and conduct rules.



Getting around

The dormitory is located in 15-20 minutes walking from the university. However, if in a hurry, you can take a bus back and forth (35 P one way ticket)



When in trasport, you can either pay in cash, by card, or with an App (MirPay, SberPay. See restrictions of other Apps below). Also, you can buy a monthly unlimited transport pass at a discounted price for students (800-900 P).

Taxi services is another available means of transport. It is not common here to catch taxi in the street - most people use Apps, the most popular of which is **Yandex Taxi** (browse to download in English). This App automatically calculates the price of a trip depending on a distance. Taxis are paid with a money transfer, in cash, or automatically by App (card readers are not always available). **Note!** Drivers don't initially see the final destination, so may cancel their placement at anytime before you are inside the cab.





Payments and banking

Once you come to MASU, we will help you to obtain a Russian bank card (based on the national payment system MIR). Currently, most VISA, Master Card etc. cards are not accepted in Russia, if they were issued in another country.

There are several possible ways of performing payment for goods and services:

- Cash in ₱ (you can change € or \$ in most bank offices)
- Money transfer (through cheques or Apps)



To always stay in touch, do not forget to buy a SIM card from one of the Russian operators (see below). You can get acquainted with the service plans and costs at points of sale in any of the shopping centers of Murmansk.







Shopping

There are hundreds of shops of various sizes in Murmansk where you can buy food, consumer products, clothes etc. There are at least 3 supermarkets close to the dorm (see 2gis and other map Apps for more info). Almost all shops are open from 9:00 to 22:00 (some work 24h). On average, students spend 7000-10000 ₱ a month on food and necessary goods or services. Below is the list of most popular shopping chains:

Chemists / pharmacies / drugstores of various brands are also found everywhere and are usually marked with a green cross sign.

Document copies

For the periods of your registration in the Migration Police or visa extension, your documents are kept by the the International Cooperation Office. Therefore, students should keep printed and electronic copies of:

- Passport
- Visa
- Migration card
- Registration card (previous if available)

Copies must be prepared in advance (ask university staff for help or visit a copy center at str. Egorova, 14, office 102, first door on the left. The cost of 1 A4 sheet (print or copy) is 25 P, paid by card or in cash. Students can print out their papers and other documents there as well).





Safety

As we already mentioned, Russia and Murmansk in particular are rather safe to be in, but follow the following rules:

- Fasten seatbelts when in transport
- Watch for your personal belongings
- Be careful at night and in desolated areas
- Russian traffic is right-handed, so look at right and left when crossing the street.
 Cross it ONLY at zebra, green light, and when all the cars stopped
- Be moderate if drinking alcohol
- Avoid taking any unknown substances
- Do not get involved in any kind of conflicts
- Pay attention to the expiry dates of foods you buy
- Obey silence rules from 22.00 to 10.00
- Remember emergency number: 112

As an international student, you will have to undergo several compulsory procedures to stay in Russia legally.

- In summer, your can rent bicycles and electric scooters in the city center. Please, ask your mates for help.
- Alcohol is sold 11.00 to 21.00 for persons 18+. It is strictly prohibited to consume alcohol at the dorm or university premises.
